

**HARDING TOWNSHIP
ORDINANCE NO. 03-15**

**CAPITAL ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HARDING, IN THE COUNTY
OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING THE MAKING OF VARIOUS
PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS AND ACQUISITIONS IN, BY AND FOR THE
TOWNSHIP AND APPROPRIATING THEREFOR THE SUM OF \$810,000
(\$515,000 FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND AND
\$295,000 FROM CAPITAL SURPLUS)**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Harding, in the County of Morris, New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The Township of Harding, in the County of Morris, New Jersey (the "Township"), is hereby authorized to make the following public improvements and acquisitions in, by and for the Township, including all work, materials and appurtenances necessary and suitable therefore:

CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND

Projects	Estimated Costs
a. Exterior and Interior Improvements at all Township facilities (Kirby Hall, Bayne Park, Show Grounds, Barrett Field, Tunis Ellicks House and Public Works) including environmental remediation at Public Works, archive filing system, furniture and security equipment.	\$ 137,500
b. Acquisition / Upgrade of various audio, visual and computer equipment and systems	\$ 41,000
c. Replacement/Repair of Basins, Pipes and Culverts; Seal Coat Roads	\$ 75,000
d. Implementation of COAH Obligation, including design, construction and sewer capacity for additional units at the Township's affordable housing project; Special Needs Housing and Affordable Accessory Residence	\$ 215,000
e. Exterior and Interior Improvements at the Farm at Harding	\$ 25,000
f. Acquisition of various equipment including plows, trailer and recycling box	\$ <u>21,500</u>
Total from Capital Improvement Fund	\$ 515,000

CAPITAL SURPLUS

Projects	Estimated Costs
a. Acquisition and construction of a salt dome at Public Works	\$ 60,000
b. Improvements of Township-Owned Tennis Courts at Kirby Municipal Building	\$ 85,000
c. Road Reconstruction, including all design, work, materials and appurtenances, including Kitchell Road Resurfacing project	\$ <u>150,000</u>
Total from Capital Surplus	\$ 295,000

Section 2. The aggregate sum of \$515,000 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvement Fund of the Township to the payment of the costs of the improvements and acquisitions authorized and described in Section 1 hereof.

Section 3. The aggregate sum of \$295,000 is hereby appropriated from Capital Surplus of the Township to the payment of the costs of the improvements and acquisitions authorized and described in Section 1 hereof.


Section 4. Said improvements and acquisitions are lawful capital improvements of the Township having a period of usefulness of at least five (5) years. Said improvements and acquisitions shall be made as general improvements, no part of the cost of which shall be assessed against property specially benefited.

Section 5. The capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this capital ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. The resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Township Clerk and is available there for public inspection.

Section 6. This capital ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication as required by law.
