

**TOWNSHIP OF HARDING
ORDINANCE NO. 03-12**

“CAPITAL ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HARDING, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING THE MAKING OF VARIOUS PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS AND ACQUISITIONS IN, BY AND FOR THE TOWNSHIP AND APPROPRIATING THEREFOR THE SUM OF \$350,500 FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND”

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Harding, in the County of Morris, New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The Township of Harding, in the County of Morris, New Jersey (the “Township”), is hereby authorized to make the following public improvements and acquisitions in, by and for the Township, including all work, materials and appurtenances necessary and suitable therefor:

CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND

<u>Purpose</u>	<u>Estimated Costs</u>
a. Exterior and Interior Improvements at Township facilities including Town Hall, Bayne Park and Public Works including environmental remediation at Public Works	\$ 118,000
b. Acquisition / Upgrade of various audio visual and computer equipment	\$ 14,500
c. Public Improvements in the Redevelopment Zone including all work, materials and appurtenances necessary	\$ 95,000
d. Exterior and Interior Improvements at the Farm at Harding	\$ 25,000
e. Design and construction of additional units at the Township’s affordable housing project, including acquisition of sewer capacity	\$ 25,000
f. Basins: Replacement/Repairs; Pipe: Replacement/Repairs/Culvert Repairs; Roads: Seal Coat	\$ 70,000
g. Department of Public Works: Acquisition of various equipment including vehicle diagnostic scanner	\$ 3,000
Total from Capital Improvement Fund	\$ 350,500

Section 2. The aggregate sum of \$350,500 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvement Fund of the Township to the payment of the costs of the improvements and acquisitions authorized and described in Section 1 hereof.


Section 3. Said improvements and acquisitions are lawful capital improvements of the Township having a period of usefulness of at least five (5) years. Said improvements and acquisitions shall be made as general improvements, no part of the cost of which shall be assessed against property specially benefited.

Section 4. The capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this capital ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. The resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Township Clerk and is available there for public inspection.

Section 5. This capital ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication as required by law.
