Animal Control Solutions is prepared to respond to emergencies <u>24/7</u> during this challenging time. We are closely following all guidelines recommended by the CDC and local health officials to help control the spread of the COVID-19. We are taking every precaution to protect the residents we serve and our staff. <u>Beginning on Monday March 16th</u>, we will make the following changes to our normal operations.

- 1. Rabies quarantining of animals involved in bite incidents will be conducted via the telephone unless the animal is deemed potentially dangerous. At the end of the quarantine, proof of quarantine will be required from owner.
- 2. For minor incidents such as barking dogs, nuisance wildlife, or stray cats, an animal control officer may not respond to the residence. Instead, the caller will speak directly with an animal control officer who will take a report of the incident for future action if necessary.
- 3. When picking up confined stray dogs, we ask that the finder meet the animal control officer with the animal outside of their residence.
- 4. Animal Control Officers have been instructed to maintain a distance of 6 to 12 feet from the public at all times.
- 5. Animal control officers have been instructed not to enter a residence under any circumstance unless deemed an emergency.
- 6. Unless emergent, issuing summonses and court appearances will be on hold for the next two weeks.
