AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HARDING, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF  
NEW JERSEY AMENDING CHAPTER 250, ARTICLE I OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF  
HARDING, SPECIFICALLY §250-1 ENTITLED "SPEED LIMITS"

WHEREAS, via Ordinance 13-2020, the speed limit on Sand Spring Road was changed from 35 miles per hour (MPH) to 25 MPH; and

WHEREAS, following the adoption of Ordinance 13-2020, the Township commissioned a review of the traffic patterns created by the Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, following a report issued by Brightview Engineering dated September 23, 2024, attached hereto as **Exhibit A**, it was determined that the speed limit for Sand Spring Road from Route 202 to Bockoven Lane should remain 25 MPH, while the speed limit for Sand Spring Road from Bockoven Lane to Blue Mill Road should be changed to 35 MPH ; and

WHEREAS, based upon the recommendation of the Brightview Engineering report, the Township seeks to amend the Ordinance to reflect the change in speed limit.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Harding in the County of Morris, State of New Jersey that Chapter 250, Article I, §250-1 of the Code of the Township of Harding is hereby amended as follows [additions to ordinance are underlines; deletions have strikethrough]: to add the following speed limit:

SECTION 1. § 250-1. **Speed limits.**

The following speed limits are established for both directions of traffic along the specified roads within the Township:

SECTION 2. At least three copies of said full Ordinance are on file in the Office of the Municipal Clerk for public examination and acquisition. Copies are available for inspection or acquisition during regular weekday working hours and arrangements have been made for the publication of said proposed Ordinance in pamphlet or other similar form which will be available for purchase from the Township Clerk.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication according to law.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions.


