Warren G. Harding III is the great-nephew of the township's namesake, President Warren G. Harding. He is a retired orthopedic surgeon who is also an expert on his great-uncle. He has edited two books on the president: *Our Common Country* and *Practical Idealism: Warren G. Harding*.

The Honorable Rodney P. Frelinghuysen was the Representative of New Jersey's 11th District from 1995 to 2019. He is the son of Peter Frelinghuysen, Jr., who was the Representative of New Jersey's 5th District from 1953 to 1975.

The Harding and Frelinghuysen families were long-time friends and political allies. Joseph S. Frelinghuysen, Sr. often played golf with Warren G. Harding while they served together in the Senate. As president, Harding was visiting Frelinghuysen's estate in Raritan, NJ, when Congress passed the Knox-Porter Resolution, which ended America's involvement in World War I. It was sent to the President at the Frelinghuysen estate where it was signed into law.
