Materials that will **NOT** be collected:

Building materials Any Recyclable items
Household garbage Toxic/hazardous chemicals
Stones, concrete Propane bottles or tanks

Soil 55-gallon drums (empty or full)

Brush Oil tanks

Yard Debris Oil-based paints

• Lawnmowers and other gasoline powered equipment must have the gas and oil drained.

- Hot water heaters and water conditioners must be drained.
- Pipes and single pieces of lumber must be cut or bent into sections four (4) feet or less in length.
- Latex paints must be opened and completely dried out.

Please do not leave items in front of property sooner than ten (10) days prior to the October 2nd collection date.

Materials that will **not** be collected curbside, but **are accepted** at the recycling center:

All standard recyclables: (newspaper, cardboard, glass, aluminum, plastics)

TVs and related electronic devices.

Barbeque size propane tanks

Computers, printers and peripherals

Tires
