

**HARDING TOWNSHIP

Meeting Minutes

Dr. Lacz, Vice Chair called the June 13, 2024 meeting of the Harding Township Board of Health to order at 7:34 p.m., and announced the meeting was called in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.

MINUTES FROM APRIL 11, 2024 BOARD OF HEALTH MEETING:

Dr. Lacz asked if there were any questions with regard to the April 11, 2024 minutes. Upon a motion made by Mrs. Somers, seconded by Mr. DeNave, and with a vote of all ayes, none opposed, the minutes for the April 11, 2024, meeting minutes were accepted.

MONTHLY HEALTH DEPARTMENT REPORT FOR APRIL/MAY 2024:

Dr. Lacz asked if there were any questions regarding the monthly Health Department reports for April and May 2024.

Mrs. Sharp informed the Board that the water testing of the Municipal Building for the months of April and May were satisfactory.

Mr. Byrnes reported that 126 Lee's Hill Road septic permit (2nd extension) was set to expire shortly. They have had three years to install the septic. The contractor was able to meet the deadline and the septic work has been completed. Mr. Byrnes reported that he is currently busy with reviewing septic applications and conducting inspections.

Dr. Lacz asked for a motion to accept the April and May 2024 monthly Health Department reports and financial reports. Upon a motion made by Mr. DeNave, seconded by Mrs. Chambers, and with a vote of all ayes, none opposed, the monthly Health Department reports for April and May 2024 were accepted.

COUNTY OF MORRIS MONTHLY REPORT OF ACTIVITIES FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF HARDING – APRIL / MAY 2024

Dr. Lacz asked if there were any comments or questions with regard to the Morris County Monthly Report.

Miss Myers reported that April and May have been slow. Miss Meyers reported that she and Miss Freer were able to shadow the Vineland Health Department for their processes. Miss Meyers reported all bathing inspections have been completed for Harding Green, Dorset Hollow, and Mt. Kemble Beach.

Mrs. Sharp reported that the Public Health Nurse will be conducting blood pressures at the Kemmerer Library and in the Municipal Building during the summer as the Seniors are not in session during the summer months. The schedule is as follows:

1. Thursdays from 11:30am to 1:30pm at the Kemmerer Library and 1:45pm to 3:00pm at the Municipal Building
2. Dates: June 13, 2024 – July 11, 2024 – August 8, 2024

With no further comments, a motion was made to accept the April and May 2024 Monthly County of Morris reports Mr. DeNave, seconded by Mrs. Chipperson, and with a vote of all ayes, none opposed the monthly Morris County reports for April and May 2024 were accepted.

BOH REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF SEPTIC PERMIT FOR 42 RED GATE ROAD, BLOCK 4, LOT 10.01:



Upon a motion to accept the permit extension request for the septic at 42 Red Gate Road was made by Mrs. Somers, seconded by Mr. DeNave, and with a roll call vote of all ayes, none opposed, the septic extension was approved.
