Resolution TC 20-114 – Resolution of the Township Committee Consenting to Assignment of Township of Harding's Solid Waste Municipal Contract With Peter Rubinetti Private Disposal LLC to Interstate Waste Services of New Jersey, Inc.

**WHEREAS**, by Resolution No. 19-198, the Township of Harding, after solicitation of public bids, awarded a contract to Peter Rubinetti Private Disposal LLC (hereinafter "Rubinetti") for solid waste and recyclable collection at municipally owned properties for a three year term commencing January 1, 2020 and terminating December 31, 2022 at an annual rate of \$65,000.00 and a total three year amount of \$195,000.00; and

**WHEREAS**, in furtherance of the award of the contract, the Township and Rubinetti executed a Contract for a 3-year term for \$195,000.00 (hereinafter the "Contract"); and

WHEREAS, the Township of Harding has been notified by Joseph Ferrnate, Jr., Esq., as Counsel for Rubinetti that Rubinetti has petitioned the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (hereinafter "NJDEP") for approval to assign it's contract with the Township to Interstate Waste Services of New Jersey, Inc. (hereinafter "Interstate") in connection with Rubinetti's sale of its assets to Interstate; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to effectuate the assignment of the Township's contract with Rubinetti to Interstate, the NJDEP requires pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26H-6, Appendix A, 3.7 the Township consent to the assignment, subject to NJDEP approval and effective upon the closing on the transfer of assets by between Rubinetti and Interstate; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Harding requires the services of a waste hauler for solid waste and recyclable collection at municipally owned properties and therefore desires to provide its consent to the assignment of the Contract from Rubinetti to Interstate, subject to NJDEP approval and effective upon the closing on the transfer of assets by between Rubinetti and Interstate and further subject to Interstate providing said services under the same terms and conditions of the Contract.

**BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Township Committee of Harding Township, Morris County, New Jersey that:

- 1. The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein and made a part hereof as set forth at length.
- 2. The Township Committee on behalf of the Township of Harding hereby consents to the assignment of the Contract by and between the Township of Harding and Peter Rubinetti Private Disposal LLC for solid waste and recyclable collection at municipally owned properties for a three year term commencing January 1, 2020 and terminating December 31, 2022 at an annual rate of \$65,000.00 and a total three year amount of \$195,000.00 and awarded pursuant to Resolution No. 19-198, subject to NJDEP approval and effective upon the closing on the transfer of assets by between Peter Rubinetti Private Disposal LLC and Interstate Waste Services of New Jersey Inc. and further subject to Interstate providing said services to the Township under the same terms and conditions of the Contract
- 3. This consent shall be submitted to the NJDEP in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:26H-6, Appendix A, 3.7

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Harding and L & T Affordable Housing Urban Renewal Corporation (hereinafter "L & T") entered into an Contract for Sale of Real Estate in connection with 700 Woodland Avenue, Block 2, Lot 16 on the tax map of the Township of Harding and otherwise known as "The Farm": and

**WHEREAS**, currently The Farm includes 24 affordable housing apartment units and as part of the Township's Court approved HEFSP, the Township agreed to construct at least two additional affordable housing apartment units at The Farm; and

**WHEREAS,** as part of the Township's agreement to sell The Farm to L & T and in accordance with the Township's Court approved HEFSP, L & T agreed to make application to the Township's Planning Board for purposes of obtaining final site plan approval for the construction of at least 2 additional affordable housing apartment units at The Farm; and

**WHEREAS,** L & T filed an application with the Planning Board on or about July 8, 2020 for purposes of obtaining preliminary and final major site plan approval for the construction of 4 additional affordable housing apartment units, an onsite office and other related improvements; and

**WHEREAS,** in light of this being an affordable housing project that is being constructed on behalf of Harding Township pursuant to the Township's agreement of sale with L & T, L & T has requested and the Township Committee has agreed to waive the requirement that L & T submit application fees that may otherwise be required by the Township's Code for this application.

**BE IT RESOLVED,** by the Township Committee of Harding Township, Morris County, New Jersey, that the foregoing background recited above is incorporated herein by refence and the Township Committee does hereby waive all application fees that may be due pursuant to the Township Code for preliminary and final major site plan approval in connection with the application filed by L & T Affordable Housing Urban Renewal Corporation with the Township Planning Board for The Farm.
